On 09/02/2017 at 11:56 a.m., Humboldt County Sheriff's Office Deputies assigned to the Garberville Station were dispatched to a motel located in the 800 block of Redwood Drive, Garberville, to investigate the report of Domestic Violence.

Upon arrival, Deputies determined that **Joshua Brandon Marcum (age 29)** was the aggressor in a Domestic Violence incident. Deputies also learned that Marcum is a California Department of Corrections (CDC) parolee and that he was wanted by CDC for parole violations. Marcum was subsequently placed under arrest for his warrant and the following charges:

- Domestic violence causing injury - PC 273.5
- Assault with force likely to cause great bodily injury - PC 245(a)(4)
- Battery with force causing great bodily injury - PC 243(d)
- Intimidating or preventing a victim from reporting a crime - PC 136.1(b)(1)

After Marcum was taken into custody, Deputies located approximately 59 grams of suspected methamphetamine in his possession. Marcum was additionally charged with possession of a controlled substance for sale - HS11378 and possession of a narcotic for sale - HS 11351.

Marcum was transported to the Humboldt County Correctional Facility where he was booked on the above charges. Due to Marcum's parole status, he is ineligible for bail at this time.
