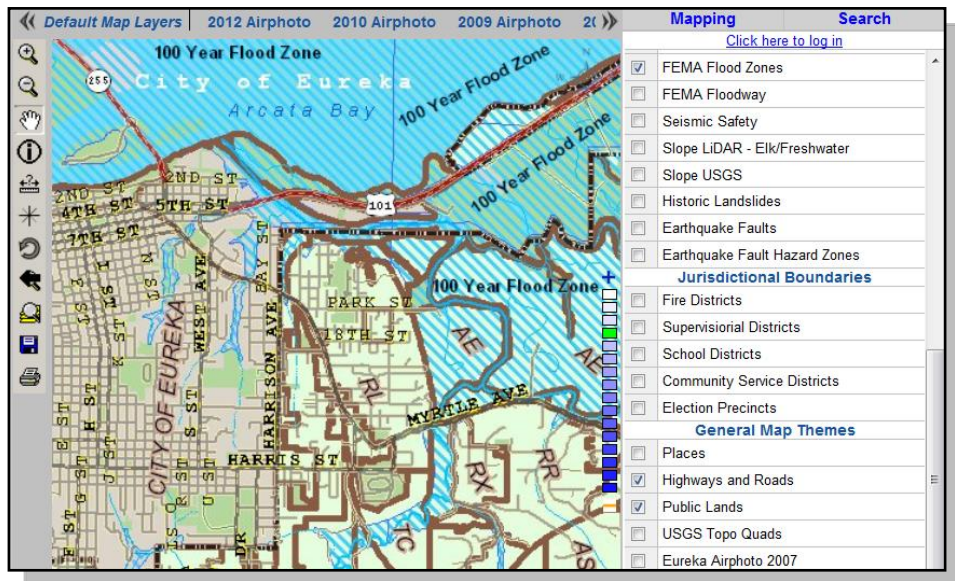
## Loads of land information available on County's Web GIS page

You can learn a lot about your residence or property by exploring a powerful feature on the County's website. After a few clicks on the Planning and Building Department's Web GIS (geographic information system) page, users can see maps illustrating designated flood zones, school district boundaries, polling locations, topographic information, and much more. The use of GIS is just one way the County is keeping pace with current technology, while providing user-friendly ways to help the public stay informed.

To access the online system, [click here](#) or go to the County's home page and search for "Web GIS." You can also type the following address into your web browser: <http://gis.co.humboldt.ca.us/>

Once there, you can get property or parcel information by:

- Clicking on the 'Planning and Building' application,
- Clicking on the 'search' link on the upper right-hand part of the page,
- Clicking on the 'Find Address' or 'Find Parcel' link, and
- Entering your address or eight-digit Assessor's Parcel Number



The GIS information is updated frequently and allows users to visually study maps that display the latest changes with regard to important issues like General Plan and land use designations. The GIS function replaces the old "zone phone" system, which is an automated phone line that gives out limited parcel information. The last day for the "zone phone" will be January 31, but the expanded capacity of Web GIS is available today.
