Resilient Rio Dell: Water System Rebuild Groundbreaking Ceremony

The water system rebuild project is a massive shot in the arm for the City of Rio Dell. With this desperately-needed infrastructure upgrade, the community will have a safe and reliable source of drinking water for decades to come. The current system, over 75 years old, has taken a beating over the years and the December 2022 earthquake brought Rio Dell's water infrastructure to near collapse.

With the rebuild being fully funded by the State of California, approved just days after the earthquake, it will save local residents approximately \$35 per month on future water bills. This is a big win and will save local residents millions of dollars over the next several decades.

The State is proud to invest in the resilience of Rio Dell for generations to come.

Water System Rebuild Fast Facts:

- 💧 Total State investment: \$12.9 million
- 💧 2.85 miles of new pipes will be buried
- 💧 279 updated service lines to local residences will be installed
- 💧 500,000 gallons of new, seismically-safe water storage will be built
- 💧 30 new fire hydrants will be built, helping make Rio Dell more fire safe
- 💧 5 new highway undercrossing segments will be constructed
